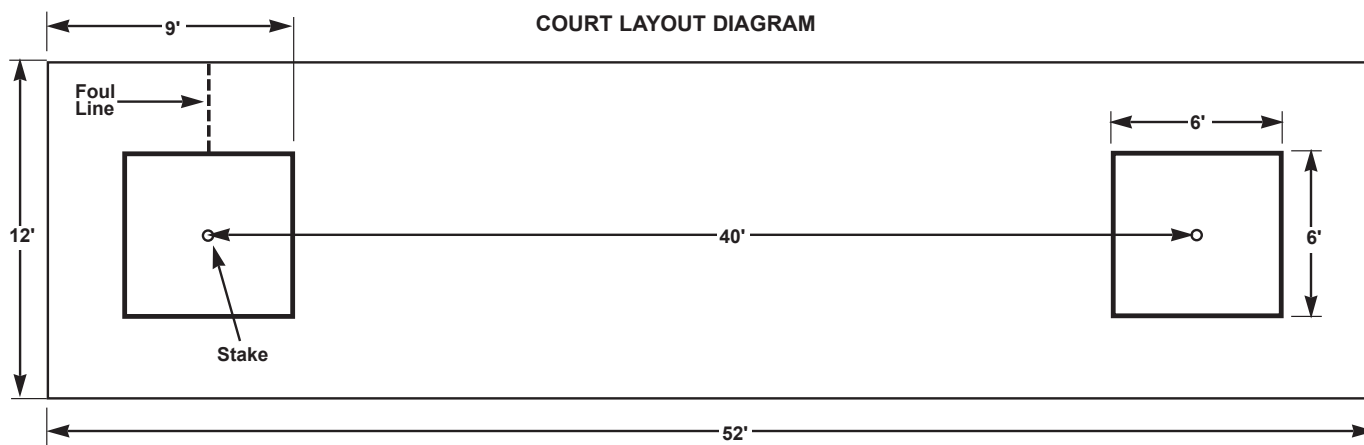

OBJECT OF THE GAME

The object of the game is to pitch (or throw) the horseshoes to encircle the stake or get as close to the stake as possible.

COURT LAYOUT

The official court size is 52' x 12' as shown in the Court Layout Diagram. However, you can play the game in almost any space available. Horseshoes can be played on any surface; sand, dirt, grass, etc.



WARNING

Always observe the rules of safety. Do not stand near the area where the horseshoes are being pitched. Never pitch the horseshoes until you are sure the pitching area is clear of everyone first.

PLAYING THE GAME

How to hold and pitch the Horseshoe

The horseshoe can be held in the middle, on one of the straight legs or virtually any position that is comfortable. The horseshoes must be pitched from behind the foul line.

Start of the Game

A coin toss can determine which player or team will pitch first. The team or player winning the toss will start the game. The first player or team will pitch all their horseshoes. Then the opposing player or team will pitch all their horseshoes.

Team mates usually play at opposite ends of the court.

Scoring

The horseshoe closest to the stake scores. The horseshoe must be within six inches (officially) of the stake to score or within any established distance agreed upon before the start of the game. Any horseshoe that encircles the stake is called a "ringer". To qualify as a ringer, you must be able to set a straight edge against both heels of the horseshoe without touching the stake. A ringer is the highest score a player can score with one horseshoe.

Points

One horseshoe closer to the stake than any of the opponents horseshoes scores 1 point.

Two horseshoes closer than any of the opponents horseshoes score 2 points.

One ringer scores 3 points.

One ringer and closest horseshoe pitched by the same player score 4 points.

Two ringers for one player or team and none for the opposing team score 6 points.

In the event of equal pitches from opposing players or teams, any points made cancel each other out. Example 1: Player A has one ringer and player B has one ringer - no points are awarded to these horseshoes. Example 2: Player A has two ringers and player B has one ringer - player A receives 3 points, player B receives no points.

The official number of points needed to win is 21. This can vary if decided upon before the start of the game.

Each game is divided into two innings. Each inning is completed when all four (4) horseshoes have been played and measured.

Any horseshoe that is moved, when hit by another, will be measured from its new position. If a player knocks one of his opponent's horseshoes from a non-ringer position to a ringer position, that horseshoe will score as a ringer and 3 points will be awarded to the holder of that horseshoe.
