

Rod Hockey

Rules of Play

The Object of the Game

The object of Rod Hockey is to be the first player to score 10 goals against the opposing player.

Beginning the Game

Matches begin with the puck placed in the center of the rink, the 2 center-forwards being on their own side. Face off is made by releasing the puck in the center of the middle circle, the 2 center-forwards being in the position above mentioned. Before releasing the puck, be sure opponent is ready.

During Play

Players attempt to pass the puck to their own players, and utilizing the rods, try to score a goal. If the puck becomes stuck on a part of the table that cannot be reached by a hockey player, the puck needs to be picked up and placed in the center for a new face-off. Each player controls his/her own offense and defense during play. The goalie can be controlled for lateral movement to block shots on goal.

Scoring

A goal is scored when the puck enters and drops inside the opponent's goal.

A face-off is required to after each goal is scored.

Winning

The first player to score 10 points is declared the winner.

Step 1- Slide all Gears #15 into tracks on the playing surface. Next slide all Rods through end panels following number order on diagram. Slide Foam Spacer #11 on to each rod. Next attach Rod Stopper #12 to each rod using M4 Bolt #37 and Nut #28. Next attach the rod to the gear using M3 Bolt #30 and Nut #31. Attach Rubber Bushing #10 to each end of the rods. Next attach Handle#1 on to each rod using bolts #32 and Nuts # 33.Next secure the goalie cover #20 to the end panel with the flat head screw #41.



Step 2- Attach Goalie Control B #22 to the end panels using Screws # 43. Next attach goalie control A #21 with goalie control B using M4 bolt #42 and Locking Nut #45. Next attach table Support Brace #39 to the center of the table using Screws #34.
